

Once you've accepted a quote, the buyer will collect your car using a recovery vehicle.

All cars must be scrapped at an Authorised Treatment Facility (ATF).

This is the Vehicle Depollution Process. Parts removed include:

- Petrol tanks
- Airbags
- Engine oil
- Coolant



Recycling

As much of the car is recycled as possible e.g. tyres and plastic.

A certificate of destruction means that 95% of your vehicle has been recycled – in line with government targets.

The car is



crushed, separated and melted down


After recycling, the car is taken to a crusher and squashed into a cube.

It then goes through 3 steps:

- 1. Magnetic separation Removing the steel
- 2. Detinning Getting rid of the tin layer on the metal
- Reforming Turning steel into sheets of metal for reuse
